Survey conducted November 1 through November 2, 2016. 2,683 likely General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2016 General Election. Margin of Error is +/- 1.89% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.

Donald Trump: 45%
Hillary Clinton: 46%
Gary Johnson: 4%
Someone else: 2%
Undecided: 3%

[TRUMP SUPPORTERS] Q: Would you say you are very enthusiastic about your candidate, somewhat enthusiastic, not so enthusiastic or not enthusiastic at all?

Very enthusiastic: 69%
Somewhat enthusiastic: 19%
Not so enthusiastic: 8%
Not enthusiastic at all: 4%

[CLINTON SUPPORTERS] Q: Would you say you are very enthusiastic about your candidate, somewhat enthusiastic, not so enthusiastic or not enthusiastic at all?

Very enthusiastic: 55%
Somewhat enthusiastic: 26%
Not so enthusiastic: 12%
Not enthusiastic at all: 7%
