On 4/29/12 I was traveling east bound on Clark Rd when in my marked patrol vehicle when I observed a white SUV traveling parallel to Clark Rd on an paved access road. The white SUV was pulling a small plastic hot wheels car with a seven year old female child inside of it. The small car was attached to the vehicle with two dog leashes tied together then tied to the trailer hitch. The child was wearing a swim suit only and had no protective gear on whatsoever. I estimated the vehicle speed to be 5 to 10 miles per hour. The access road is separated from Clark Rd by a side walk only. I initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle and made contact with the driver later identified as Paul Berloni (defendant). Upon making contact with the defendant I immediately smelled the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person. I also observed his eyes to be bloodshot and watery. I asked him for his driver's license and registration and he stated his license was revoked for 10 years for a DUI. I asked the defendant how much alcohol he had drank today and he stated two or three but later stated he had more than that but would not tell me exactly how much. His speech was slowed and slurred.

The defendant refused to perform field sobriety test. He was then taken into custody and placed in the back of the patrol vehicle.

I then made contact with Belinda Berloni (co-defendant) who was riding in the very back cargo area of the vehicle with the rear hatch open cheering the child on as she was being pulled behind the vehicle. The co-defendant was also intoxicated and stated she had a few drinks. The co-defendant also stated that she understood that it was dangerous to drag a child behind the vehicle but stated they were just having fun and had been doing this all day.

I made contact with the co-defendant's son Justin Oetting (father of the child) who arrived on scene and took custody of his child. Oetting was very upset with the co-defendant who is his mother. He stated "are you fucking stupid you should know better" to his mother. He also stated that he believed the defendant and co defendant have an alcohol problem and that may have been a factor in their decision making.

The defendant and co-defendant failed to provide adequate supervision for the child and put the child in a situation that could have easily resulted in great bodily harm, permanent disfigurement or even death. The child was thankfully unharmed during this incident.

The defendant and co-defendant were arrested and transported to the north jail without incident.

Once at the north jail I asked the defendant if he was going to provide a sample of his breath to determine the alcoholic content and he advised that he would not. I then read implied consent and he advised that he still refused.

The defendant stated he has been arrested 5 times for DUI. I was only able to find three convictions on the criminal history which makes this one his 4th or subsequent violation.
