

# **ANALYSIS: 2016 Illinois Democratic Primary**

428 Interviews with registered voters  
who plan to vote in Democratic Primary election  
Conduct March 12 , 2016  
Accuracy level +/- 4..1%

## **METHODOLOGY**

The survey was conducted by phone with registered voters in Illinois who were asked if they plan on voting in the Democratic or Republican primary election. Those who said they would be voting in the Democrat primary took the survey. This methodology allows voters who don't usually vote in a Democratic primary to be counted. The survey was conducted by telephone interviewers to conduct surveys with people who list mobile phones as their primary number (it is illegal for automated polling to call mobile phones). More than 36% of the interviews were conducted with cell phone users. Survey was not conducted for any clients and is the property of McKeon & Associates.

## **KEY FINDINGS**

- In the Democratic primary election for President, Clinton is in a statistical dead heat with Sanders. Sanders  
30% - Bernie Sanders  
31% Hillary Clinton

(Don't Read) 39%- Don't Know

- In the Democratic primary election for U S Senator from Illinois it is a statically dead heat, In our first survey Duckworth lead Harris 10 points.  
26% Napoleon Harris  
26% Tammy Duckworth  
11% Andrea Zopp

(Don't Read) 37% Don't Know

There was very low interest in both races. Many voters refused to take the survey because they were not allowed to vote for or against Trump
