**ORDER GRANTING CUSTODY AND DISPOSITION OF ANIMALS**

THIS MATTER came on to be heard April 5, 2006, before the Honorable Steven L. Selph, upon Petition to Determine Custody and Disposition of Animals filed by Grady Judd, as Sheriff of Polk County. Present at hearing was David Bergdoll, Esquire, counsel for the Sheriff and the Respondent, Hewitt Grant.

**ORDER and ADJUDGE** as follows:


- A. That the one hundred thirty-eight (138) dogs, and any other animals alive, dead, born or unborn, are hereby awarded to the Polk County Animal Services for adoption and/or disposition pursuant to Florida law. All others shall have no interest in and to said Animals.
- B. The Respondent is hereby enjoined from adopting the one hundred thirty-eight (138) dogs back from Polk County Animal Services, and is permanently enjoined from having any animals in the future.
- C. This Court finds that the cost of caring for the above described dogs to be Thirty-Eight Thousand Three Hundred Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$38,305.00) U.S. Currency. The Court orders Hewitt Grant to repay

\$38,305.00, within 90 days or with scheduled payments approved through Legal Affairs.


