8 half of the United States, by the amounts provided in such  
9 legislation for those purposes, provided that such legisla-  
10 tion would not increase the deficit over either the period  
11 of the total of fiscal years 2016 through 2020 or the pe-  
12 riod of the total of fiscal years 2016 through 2025.
