1. Do you support or oppose providing a legal way for illegal immigrants already in the United States to become US citizens?

Support	49%
Oppose	32%
Not sure	18%

2. If there were a pathway to citizenship for illegal immigrants, should illegal immigrants applying for legal status be required to pass a background check, or not?

Yes, they should need to pass a background check	88%
No, they should not need to pass a background check	4%
Not sure	9%

3. If there were a pathway to citizenship for illegal immigrants, should illegal immigrants applying for legal status be required to learn English, or not?

Yes, they should need to learn English	81%
No, they should not need to learn English	12%
Not sure	8%

4. If there were a pathway to citizenship for illegal immigrants, should illegal immigrants applying for legal status be required to currently have a job in the US, or not?

Yes, they should need to have a job in the US	63%
No, they should not need to have a job in the US	19%
Not sure	18%

5. Do you support or oppose allowing gay and lesbian Americans married to foreigners to sponsor their spouses for residency in the US, as heterosexual married Americans may do?
