Continue to operate	54%
Close down	27%
Not sure	19%

2. Do you favor or oppose holding trials for the terrorist suspects being held at Guantanamo?

Favor strongly	40%
Favor somewhat	23%
Oppose somewhat	9%
Oppose strongly	11%
Not sure	17%

3. If trials are held for terrorist suspects, should they be held in U.S. courts or military tribunals?

U.S. courts	28%
Military tribunals	52%
Not sure	20%

4. Do you think detainees in Guantanamo can be safely held in federal maximum security prisons in the U.S.?

Yes, they can	38%
No, they can't	39%
Not sure	24%

5. Based on what you know, do you think that everyone currently being held at Guantanamo is dangerous to the U.S.?

Yes	47%
