1. Currently, individuals who donate to political candidates are limited to donating no more than \$2,600 to any one candidate for a given election. Is this limit:

2. Currently, individuals who donate to political candidates are limited to donating no more than \$46,200 total to federal candidates, no matter how many they support. Is this limit:

3. Do you think that limiting individual donations to candidates helps prevent corruption in politics, or does it have no impact on corruption in politics?

It helps prevent corruption	47%

4. Do you think that limits on the total amount of money individuals can donate to candidates are a violation of free speech rights?
